

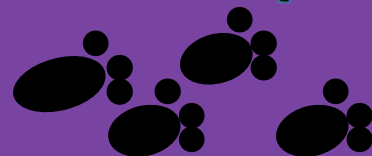
THE NODA FREAKY 5K BENEFITING AUTISM SERVICES OF MECKLENBURG COUNTY
