Coming up...

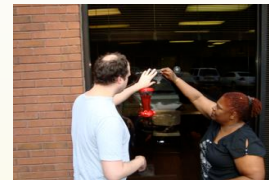
Annual fall special Lake Wylie event, Halloween and Thanksgiving parties, and we have started our crafts for selling at Christmas so we can do even more fun activities.
